Ephesians 1:15-23

I. When praying, we should thank God for the spiritual maturity He's already granted. *vv. 1:15-16a*

II. When praying, we should ask God for the spiritual perception we desperately need. *vv. 1:16b-18a*

III. When praying, we should expect the spiritual benefits that we deeply desire. vv. 1:18b-23

A. We can expect to know the hope of His calling. (Past) v. 1:18b

B. We can expect to understand the riches of His glorious inheritance. (Future) v. 1:18c

C. We can expect to experience the immeasurable greatness of His power. (Present) vv. 1:19-23

IV. Now What?

A. Pray, thanking God for at least one growing area of life.

B. Pray, asking God to help us understand our spiritual wealth in Messiah.

C. Pray, expecting God to share His power in one particular needy area.
